Project Description:

This project consisted of the road widening and upgrade of the Bruce Highway / Munro Street intersection at Babinda to facilitate a pedestrian refuge on the highway crossing. The scope of works included:

- Widening of the Bruce Highway;
- Demolition and replacement of all existing traffic islands, medians, footpaths, kerb and channel;
- Relocation of electrical services and pits to suit;
- Demolition and reinstatement of Queensland Rail Pedestrian Crossing;
- Earthworks and drainage modifications;



- Asphalt overlay; and
- Guardrail, pedestrian safety fencing and landscaping

The project contained many challenging aspects including:

- Initial design issues;
- Complex traffic control and worksite interface scenarios;
- Interfaces with the Queensland Rail freight line and
- Working in the wettest area in Australia.
