Project Description:

As part of the upgrade to the local Council's Whitsunday Coast Airport Terminal Facilities, Allciv completed the upgrade to the commercial and rental car parks.

This project involved the demolition of all existing road transport and parking facilities at the terminal and the construction of new front of house road ways, access roads, round-a-bout, bus parking and set down areas. During the construction phase the airport terminal remained operational with several flights daily, seven days a week throughout.

As part of our scope Allciv also installed a sewerage pumping and treatment system which allows the airport to recycle waste water and use this water for irrigation purposes.

Allciv staff worked closely with the council staff and consulting engineers Council to overcome issues associated with saturated ground conditions from recent floods, adjustment of the pavement design to utilize a nearby gravel source and reduce costs, and maintaining traffic flow and programming works to suit the airport operational schedule.



We were also able to offer the WRC additional works and extend the commercial car park by a further 1,800 m² and still complete the project within the original contract period and budget. The key points to note regarding the project include:

- 18,000 m² of pavement and roadways
- Installation of waste water recycling and 3 Ha irrigation system
- All works completed under traffic and continued airport operation
